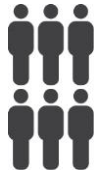
Examples of the collective impact of **donations:**

> **20 employees (\$5,200 pa)** can provide small business training for 1 year to more than 35 women who have escaped domestic violence in Timor Leste.

> **50 employees (\$13,000 pa)** can provide 85 toilets that will improve health outcomes for 430 people in Cambodia.

> **100 employees (\$26,000 pa)** can provide a community with livestock and materials to start a farm and improve food security in the Democratic Republic of Congo.

Examples assume each employee donates \$5 per week.



Examples of ways in which your staff could be **further engaged:**

> Participate in fundraising activities such as Project Compassion or Women for the World.

> Host an event at work such as Caritas Kitchen or Caritas Ks.

> Support our staff with capacity building.

> Attend our annual Women for the World event.

> Invite Caritas Australia staff to speak at your work events.

> Receive special updates and impact reports on our work.
